

Financial Assistance at Blessed Teresa of Calcutta School

(Time Sensitive Information)

We believe that your child's future is important. For families with a demonstrated need, Blessed Teresa of Calcutta has limited assistance available through Archdiocesan and Parish programs. Financial assistance is available for students in Kindergarten – 8th grade. **You must apply for the Alive in Christ Program (if eligible) before applying for the Parish Assistance program.**

Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance:

- **Alive in Christ! Scholarship Program:**
 - **Eligibility** – Any new student entering K-4th grade or a student in any grade currently attending a Catholic elementary school may apply for the scholarship.
 - **Application** – Application forms are included in the registration packet or available at the School Office. Applications will be accepted beginning January 27, 2014. Please see the application for other documentation requirements.
 - **Awards** – Scholarships are awarded on a first come, first served basis until funds are depleted. Awards range from \$1,000/year to a maximum of \$2,000/year. Recipients are notified directly by the archdiocese. Please see the enclosed flyer for additional details.

- **Catholic Family Tuition Assistance (CFTA):**
 - **Eligibility** – All Catholic families may apply for this program.
 - **Application** – Application is made online at <https://online.factsmgmt.com>. Application deadline is March 15, 2014.
 - **Awards** – Recipients are typically notified in June of each year.

Blessed Teresa Parish Tuition Assistance:

- Tuition assistance through Blessed Teresa Parish is made possible through the generosity of our parishioners and benefactors. The availability of funds will dictate the amount awarded to each family.
 - **Eligibility** – All families may apply for this program.
 - **Application** – BTC School utilizes the same online application noted above for CFTA. Catholic families who have applied for CFTA do not need to fill out a new application. Non-Catholic families should complete the application at <https://online.factsmgmt.com> and submit the required supporting information. Applications will be considered beginning April 1, 2014, and will continue as funds are available.
 - **Conference** – All families requesting parish assistance must schedule a conference with Deacon Al Love in the Parish Office (314-524-0500) after they have completed their online FACTS grant application.
 - **Awards** – Recipients are typically notified in July/August.
